

Lodge Office Spotlight of the Month

The Masonic Lodge Jewels: In England in the 1400's, under the reign of King Edward III, local governments grew out of the merchant and craft industries in each city or town. After an operative Master Stonemason created his "Master's Piece" to the satisfaction of the Master of his Craft, he was considered a "Master Mason".

Heads of the Craft became heads of their town councils, mayors, sheriffs, & ect. During this time, one of the ways which a local official proclaimed his rank was by wearing a badge of office, or jewel, on a chain around his neck. The practice is still in use today in England.

If you have ever watched a ceremony wherein Lord Mayor (Mayor in the USA) attends a formal ribbon cutting event, you would see an ornate necklace which is a medallion, signature of his office, around his neck. Masonic Lodge Officers carry over this ancient craft tradition, today, in the form of the symbolic "jewels" of their offices.
