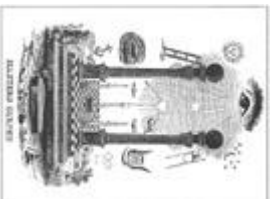

This Month in Masonic History

Dec. 5th 1730 – Benjamin Franklin's 'Pennsylvania Gazette' included news about several Lodges of Freemason's meeting in the 'province'. Franklin was not yet a Freemason when his newspaper printed this item.

Dec. 26th 1972 – Harry S. Truman, former President of the US, Past Grand Master of Missouri, and a very active freemason, died. He had requested a Masonic Funeral, but instead the government, which handled the details, permitted a short Masonic ceremony during the funeral service.

San Janinto Monument

The San Jacinto Monument is a 568ft. high column located on the Houston Ship Channel in Harris County, TX, near the city of LaPorte, TX. The monument is topped with a 220ton Star that commemorates the site of the Battle of San Jacinto, the decisive battle of the Texas Revolution. The monument, constructed from 1936 thru 1939 & dedicated on April 21, 1939, is the world's tallest monumental column and is part of the San Jacinto Battleground State Historic Site. By comparison, the Washington Monument is 556ft. tall. The column is an octagonal shaft faced with TX Cordova shellstone, topped with a 34ft Lone Star – the symbol of TX.

The San Jacinto Museum of History is located inside the base of the monument, and focuses on the history of the Battle of San Jacinto, Texas culture & heritage...
