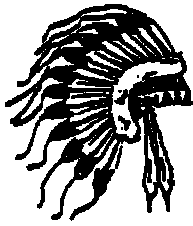

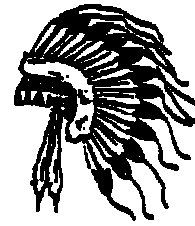

THE OKLAHOMA MASONIC INDIAN DEGREE TEAM WAS ORGANIZED IN THE LATE 1950'S. THE TEAM CONSISTS OF 15 ACTIVE MEMBERS, 11 OF WHICH ARE PAST MASTERS.

Nine recognized tribes are represented: Apache, Cherokee, Choctaw, Creek, Oneida, Osage, Ottawa, Seminole, and Sycamore. States visited include: Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Massachusetts, Minnesota, Missouri, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York and Texas. Oklahoma lodges represented are: Catoosa Lodge #185, Cherokee #10, Delta #425, Daylight #542, Dustin #336, Ottawa #492, Sapulpa #170 and Skiatook #416. While the team welcomes telephone inquiries, they will only confirm written requests from a lodge. Written requests are honored by the earliest postmark. Occasionally they will have requests for the same date. In the State of Oklahoma, the team does not require travel expenses. They do however, accept contributions to offset their expenses. When they travel out of state, they ask the host lodge to furnish their transportation, lodging and meal expenses.
