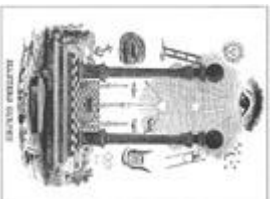

John Wayne (The Duke)
(May 25th, 1907 – June 11th, 1979)

Birth Name: Marion Robert Morrison

John Wayne, an American Icon, was raised to a MM on Saturday July 11th, 1970 at Marion McDaniel Lodge No. 56 F & AM, in Tucson, Arizona. He became a 32nd Degree Scottish Rite Mason and later joined the Al Malaikah Shrine Temple in Los Angeles and became a York Rite Mason. He was initiated into DeMolay in 1924 at the Glendale, CA Chapter and received the DeMolay Legion of Honor in 1970. Before his death in May 1979, he was awarded the US Congressional Gold Medal. He followed his father's footsteps in Masonry as his father was a Mason as well.
