The *Race for the Children* began in 2005, when members of Lewisville Lodge 201 reenergized the Lodge's commitment to public education in our community. In that first year, 96 runners registered for the Race, and \$400 was raised and donated to Lewisville ISD. With each passing year we have had an increase in the number of participants, raising over \$25,000 since then and going strong into our 8th Race this September. In the 2011-2012 academic year, \$3,000 in scholarship money was awarded to Lewisville ISD. Beneficiaries of the Race are the *Texas Scottish Rite Hospital for Children and Lewisville ISD Education Foundation*

About the Beneficiaries

- The *Texas Scottish Rite Hospital for Children* was established in 1921, when local Masons approached Dallas's first orthopedic surgeon, Dr. W. B. Carrell, with the idea of caring for children with polio, regardless of their family's ability to pay for services. When polio was virtually eradicated by the introduction of vaccines in the mid-1950's, the Hospital began to expand its treatment services to other areas of medicine, and today the Hospital is a world leader in the treatment of pediatric orthopedic conditions and dyslexia. It has treated more than 200,000 children since its establishment, and continues to provide more than 40,000 clinic visits and hospital stays to Texas children each year *at no cost to their families*. - Mirabeau Lamar succeeded Sam Houston as President of the Republic of Texas in 1838. During his administration, he convinced the legislature to set aside 9 miles of land for each county, for the benefit of public schools in that county, and an additional 150 miles were set aside for the support of two universities. These land set-asides laid the foundation for a Texas-wide public school system, and it is in emulation of such a spirit that contributions to the *Lewisville ISD Education Foundation* are made. The *LISD Education Foundation* uses their funds to aid in the furtherance of students' (more than 50,000 at present) and teachers' worthy pursuits, and encompasses recipients from the City of Lewisville as well as 12 surrounding communities. Each year the Foundation awards teacher grants and fellowships, excellence awards, program scholarships and senior scholarships.
