

This Month in Masonic History

Sept. 4th, 1820 – James Polk, US President 1845-1849, received his 1rst degree in Columbia Lodge #31, Tennessee.

Sept. 12th, 1826 – William Morgan, who had published an expose of Masonic secrets, was taken from the jail in Canandaigua, New York, kidnapped and possibly later murdered. This was the trigger for the Morgan Affair & the Anti-masonic movement and Anti-mason Party in the US from the 1820's through the 1840's.

Sept. 14, 1844 – The Grand Lodge was founded.

Sept. 15th, 1851 – The Grand Lodge of Oregon was formed.

Sept. 18th, 1793 – The cornerstone of the US Capitol building in Washington, D.C. was laid in an elaborate, formal Masonic ceremony, with George Washington personally playing a key role & wearing Masonic regalia.

Sept. 30th, 1949 – Gerald Ford, US President 1974-1977, received his first degree in Malta Lodge #465 in Grand Rapids, MI.
